From the Directors Desk

When Aaron arrived at The Anchorage, he was at the lowest point in his life. He dropped out of high school. He had a seven-year addiction to Methamphetamines. He tried treatment twice and relapsed shortly after leaving both programs. He concluded that he was hopelessly addicted and would probably die of an overdose. His mother died six months ago, he had two children with his girlfriend and the children had been removed from their home by the Department of Family and Children Services. He couldn't hold a job and he only came to the Anchorage because his girlfriend begged him.

We would probably all agree his prospects for a bright future look grim. That is where God's grace enters the picture. God specializes in lost causes: from Moses to King David, the Apostle Paul, and the Samaritan woman at the well. As God told the Apostle Paul, "My grace is sufficient for you." At the Anchorage we believe God's grace is sufficient for all men and women. Hearing the gospel of Jesus Christ is the first step toward receiving God's grace.

Aaron was exposed to the scriptures while attending chapel services and classes at the Anchorage. He began to have a glimmer of hope and believed that his life would be different. He invested himself in the Bible studies and his treatment. All of this resulted in him professing Christ as his Lord and Savior and led to him being baptized in our chapel. In our Aftercare program he has worked a fulltime job and is making good progress in his faith and treatment. He has a long way to go but now he is taking it "one day at a time" and trusting God.
